Please join our lobby of Greenwich council in support of Unite Sanctuary members.

We will ask councillors to prevent Sanctuary's executive from making severe cuts to care workers' pay and conditions.

Our members provide essential care services to vulnerable residents. The homes are run by Sanctuary Care but largely council funded.

These cuts will harm staff, residents and service users.

The employer is threatening to:

- Cut annual leave.
- Cut bank holiday pay.
- Cut the first 3 days' sick pay.
- Cut occupational sick pay.
- Increase working hours.

There is no financial logic to the cuts; Sanctuary recorded an operating surplus of £198m in 2018, and the CEO's salary was at least £350K for the year.

We demand that pay and conditions are improved, and that Sanctuary managers cease bullying and harassing Unite members.
