- Peabody plans to drastically cut its Neighbourhood Managers and has done away with the Community Services team.
- We believe these cuts will cost lives; staff trained to intervene in domestic violence, abuse, and anti-social behaviour cases have gone.
- The service now lies with a smaller team, with less time, resources, and expertise for supporting tenants, residents and service users.
- The cuts put the physical and psychological welfare of tenants, residents, service users and staff in danger.
- Peabody reported a surplus of £149 million in 2019. The cuts will save £1 million but will not be used to reduce rents or service charges, or increase frontline staff pay.

Cuts to neighbourhood services are evident in too many housing associations. A sector worth c £20 billion must stop squeezing staff, cutting services, raising service charges, and dismantling both staff and tenant democracy.
